Prayer Space in St Andrew's last week

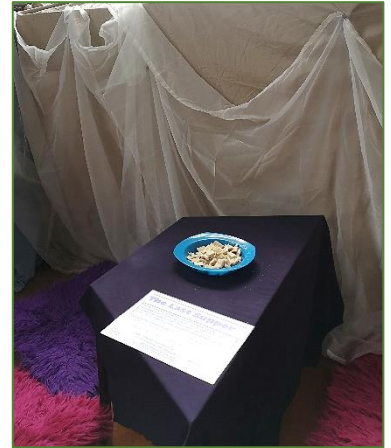
All the pupils from Shrivenham Primary School took part in Prayer Space in St Andrew's Church last week.

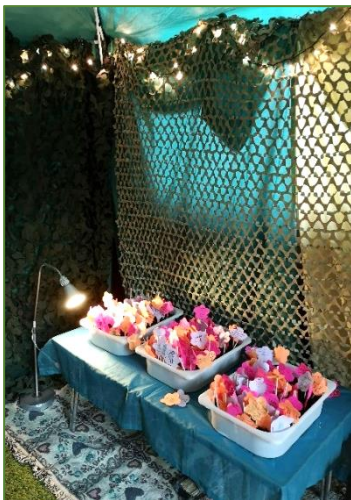
