In the GOSPEL TODAY

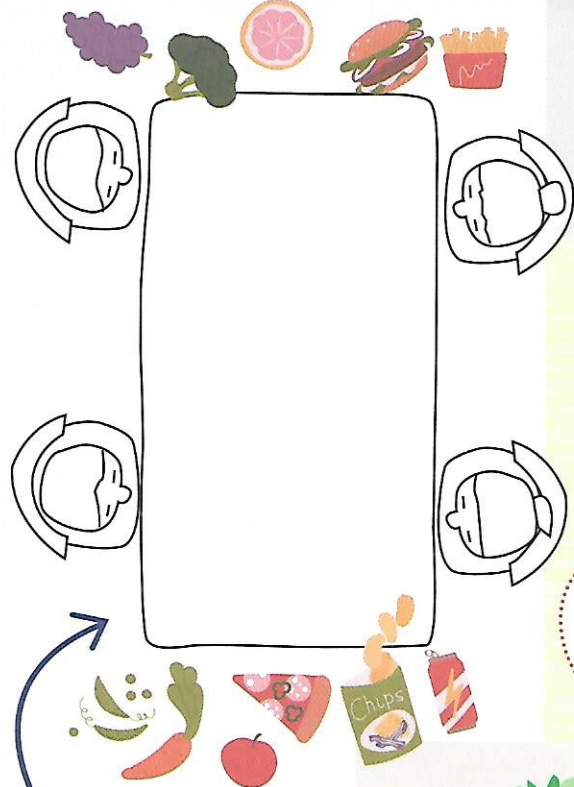
